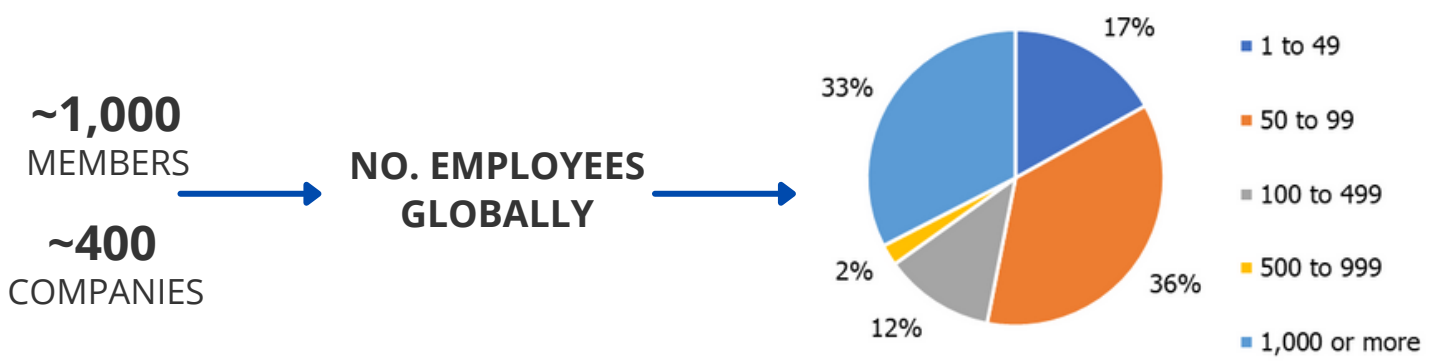

## OUR COMMITTEES

**Business Angel** = An angel investor programme that supports enthusiastic Hong Kong entrepreneurs by connecting them with investors and offers professional advice.

**Business Policy Unit** = Acts as the 'think-tank' within the Chamber, co-ordinating cross-sectoral policy issues that are important to businesses in Hong Kong.

**China Committee** = Develops and capitalises on wider business and government networks to help deliver advice to members and to reflect their views on China-related issues.

**Construction Industry Group** = Provides advice to the Chamber on matters involving the Construction Industry and organises information seminars and/or events of interest to Chamber members.

**Creative Industries Committee** = Aims to strengthen the positions of Hong Kong as an international cultural metropolis and an international tourism hub.

**CSR Committee** = Aims to raise awareness of CSR issues and best practice in Hong Kong.

**Education Committee** = An authoritative voice on educational issues that affect British business in the Hong Kong.

**Environmental & Energy Committee** = Aims to raise awareness, highlight business risks, facilitate dialogue and provide support for organisations on environment and energy matters.

**Financial Markets Committee** = Highlights issues and provides advice to the General Committee on matters involving the financial services industry.

**Future Leaders Committee** = Focuses on and addresses the needs of Hong Kong's young professionals through social and educational activities.

**Healthcare Committee** = To be an authoritative voice on healthcare issues affecting our members and on developments in the healthcare sector.

**Innovation & Technology Committee** = Reviews development and Government policies that affect business in Hong Kong and the region and provides advice and information to the Chamber and input to Government as appropriate.

**International Infrastructure Forum** = Provides members interested in outbound infrastructure with a network and point of institutional focus within the Chamber.

**Logistics Committee** = Actively supports logistics industry activities and events in Hong Kong, whilst connecting collaboratively with other logistics industry associations, organisations and committees.

**Marketing & Communications Committee** = Provides leadership on issues and opportunities that affect marketing and communications professionals in Hong Kong and also supports the wider Chamber marketing activities.

**Real Estate Committee** = Reviews and comments on Government legislation and regulations; promotes the free market of Hong Kong and its standing as a regional and international business centre.

**Retail & Hospitality Committee** = Shares relevant best practice, provides support and advice to the retail and hospitality industry, and aims to educate and innovate by contributing to the Chamber's programme of events.

**Scottish Business Group** = Provides a central business contact point for all current and new Chamber members who have an interest in Scotland, or Scottish related business.

**SME & Start-up Committee** = Provides small and medium enterprises (SMEs) and start-ups with support and acts as a voice on their behalf within the Chamber.

**Smart Cities Forum** = Creates a platform for discussion about what would make Hong Kong a smart and liveable city today and in 2050.

**Women in Business Committee** = Represents the interests of the female executives of the Chamber, contributing to policy work, and engages in dialogue with the wider business community.
